### Canteen Duties - What's Required ?

Firstly a great big welcome to our new Canteen Conveners for 2010, Justine Henkel and Kylie Radford.

Profits from the canteen make up a significant proportion of the funds necessary to run the club every year, what with the purchase of new and replacement jerseys; trophies for the children to mention just a few items.

Therefore it is imperative that our canteen provides the best service available with a wide variety of food and beverages for not only the children but also their

parents/guardians and supports along with visitors to our home ground. To achieve this it is necessary to ensure that the canteen conveners are supported by volunteers from within our own club.

With this in mind it has been decided that one parent from each team will be required to assist in the canteen for a period of 30 minutes following their child's game. Should it be determined that there are many volunteers at any one time one of the canteen conveners will release volunteers from their commitment. All volunteers

are asked to complete and sign the Canteen Volunteer Register in the canteen upon arrival.

Given that we only host 8 home games a year it is anticipated that each family will only need to volunteer to assist in the canteen once throughout the season.

Team Coaches and Managers are asked to brief their parents and identify a volunteer prior to the commencement of their respective game.

### MUSTA Parade - Saturday 27 February 2010 "Be There"

On Saturday the 27 February 2010 all registered players are requested to attend the Musta Parade at the Home Grounds of the Currimundi United Churches Club.
